Curriculum Items

- EQAO Results: Grade 3 Reading 58.8%, Writing 58.8%, Math 11.8% Grade 6 Reading 84.8%,
 Writing 80.4, Math 34.8%
- Continued emphasis on Mathematics provincially
- We will be receiving an 8 -week block form Literacy Lead teachers in the upcoming months. They will be focusing on instructional support for our primary grades.
- In-school and after-school tutoring supports- Through Ministry funding, we have extra support for literacy and math for students who are near provincial standards. This support ends this month.
- Classroom staff released for work on Number Talks and Computational fluency. Also beginning work on Learning Skills

School Generated Funds:

- Plan submitted yearly. Includes supporting graduation costs, presenters, technology purchases, school yard enhancements, Charitable donations, liturgical activities, athletics, and curriculum support.
- Plans for pizza and milk days for fundraising

Extra-Curricular

- Intermediate Volleyball- We hosted the Intermediate Volleyball tournaments. The boy's team
 fell short of qualifying despite a great effort. The girls advanced to the Family tournament
 where they continued to demonstrate perseverance and skill, winning the family level. They
 advanced to the Boards where they will compete December 8th
- Intermediate Invitation Soccer tournament this week.
- Eco Initiatives- Pursuing Platinum Certification. New name is St. Jean Brebeuf Evergreens.
 Initiatives include. Daily announcements to remind students of initiatives, litterless lunches, boomerang lunch, encourage refillable water bottles, seedlings for peace garden, etc. Currently measuring/weighing garbage output. It is about 25 pounds daily. Our goal is to reduce that amount significantly by promoting wasteless lunches.
- Christmas Open House: crafts, painting, dance, Santa, caroling, family Photos in Library, hot chocolate and cookies.
